Dear Presidents,

I read about the recent summit in Hainan and in particular on your positions for the monetary system.

I beg to observe that no monetary reform, national or international, can be valid if it continues to be based on legal tender.

This is for two reasons:

first of all, because the legal tender currency has no real value and represents non-existent goods (a currency with real value does not need the legal tender);

secondly, because the legal tender currency is controlled by very few people who control the banking system and, through this, the public and private finance, economics, information and politics of each country and then the whole world .

If you really want to free your people, create value and then returns value to work, we should adopt a new world currency entirely guaranteed by the real value and based on future work needed to produce goods and services with the same money can be paid.

In 2001, we issued Dhana, a currency since issuing guaranteed by capitals of enterprises with a value equivalent to that of a gram of platinum for Dhana.

And we decided to assign 100 Dhana to each inhabitant of the planet at least 16 years old to repayment of the cost of issuance or commitment to give back 100 hours of work in one or more times within five years from the assignment.

And we set a maximum issuance of 100 Dhana for each assignee more just a 5 per cent to be allocated to humanitarian initiatives.

This is, in our humble opinion, the only alternative to the hegemony of the dollar and the current banking system.

It seems a utopia but it is not true.

It is the only real solution, possible, fair and useful.

And, anyway, every utopia is that until it becomes reality.
